



Tuition-Free Community College Now Available



How Community College Opportunity Grants make Community College affordable:

Community College Opportunity Grants are awards that will pay the costs of tuition and approved educational fees not already covered by other available grants applied to the student's account for New Jersey residents with an annual adjusted gross income (AGI) between \$0 and \$65,000. For New Jersey residents with AGIs between \$65,001 and \$80,000 CCOG will pay up to half of the maximum CCOG award available at the college

Who is eligible for tuition-free Community College:

Community College Opportunity Grants are available to students who meet the following eligibility requirements:

- Be a New Jersey resident with a total household adjusted gross income between \$0 - \$80,000
- Complete the FAFSA or NJ Alternative Financial Aid Application by applicable state deadlines
- Enroll in at least six (6) credits per semester at any of New Jersey's community colleges during Academic Year 2023-2024
- Have no prior college degree
- Make satisfactory academic progress
