



Provider Eligibility

To be eligible for participation in the Primary Care Practitioner Loan Redemption Program of New Jersey (NJLRP), provider applicants:

- Must have completed graduate training/ residency program under the following disciplines and primary care specialties:

- Must be a resident of New Jersey
- Must maintain a current license to practice in the State of New Jersey Must agree to practice primary care on a [full-time basis](#)
- for a minimum of two years at NJLRP approved site Must have outstanding medical/ dental/ graduate school [qualifying educational loans](#)
- Must be free of judgments or defaults on qualifying educational loans
- Cannot simultaneously participate in the federally administered [U.S. Department of Health & Human Services National Health Service Corps](#) while participating in the NJLRP
